Notice is hereby given that a General Election shall be held in Stephens County for the Town of Martin. The election will be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023 for the purpose of electing two (2) City Council positions and Mayor.

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. 21-2-131 (a) (1) of the Georgia Election Code, notice is hereby given that the Mayor and City Council has established a fee on \$90.00 as a qualifying fee per candidate for Council and a fee of \$144.00 as a qualifying fee per candidate for Mayor. Qualifying for all candidates shall begin on Monday, August 21, 2023 and continue through Wednesday, August 23, 2023, from 10:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Tugalo St. Toccoa, GA 30577 on October 16, 2023 through November 3, 2023 from 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. Polls will be open from 7:00 am until 7:00 p.m. on Tuesday, November 7, 2023, Election Day at Martin Community Center located at 4014 Historic Hwy. 17 Martin, GA 30557.

Should a runoff election be required, such runoff will be held on Tuesday, December 5, 2023.
