Public Comment Opportunities for the *Stephens County Hazard Mitigation Plan*

The Georgia Mountains Regional Commission (GMRC) is assisting Stephens County and its municipalities with the update of their joint *Hazard Mitigation Plan*, the document used by local governments to shape investment in emergency response programs. Information collected during this process will help the local law enforcement, fire, and emergency response departments prioritize future improvement programs and budgets.

As part of this process, the public is invited to offer their thoughts and concerns about hazardous events in Stephens County and how the local governments can better prepare for mitigation and response. An online survey is available through the end of July that will allow residents and business owners to provide comments.

Additionally, GMRC staff will be available at the Senior Citizen Center at different times on July 11 for anyone wishing to drop in, ask questions, and submit comments. (There is no presentation during these times – Residents may come at any time during the available windows.)
